## **CASE STATEMENT:**

- North Cascades Institute is a conservation organization focused on outdoor learning in the mountains, rivers, forests and communities of the North Cascades ecosystem.
- Transformative learning experiences in nature include: place-based environmental education, outdoor recreation, and related outdoor activities that promote health and wellness, conservation, environmental justice and community engagement.
- Ecosystems thrive when communities have opportunities for meaningful experiences outdoors in nature, from a neighborhood garden to a national park. We have a shared responsibility to open the doors to people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds to ensure their outdoor experiences are powerful and rewarding. When people connect with nature, communities are strengthened, nature is protected, and we all benefit.
