Remote Emergency Medical Technician (REMT)

Comprehensive 26-day in-person course for professionals seeking EMT certification enhanced with training in a wide range of higher-level skills critical for backcountry wilderness settings.

WHEN: Jan 11 - Feb 5, 2021

COST: \$4,225

INCLUDED: 26 days on-site instruction, lodging and meals.



Hybrid Wilderness First Responder (H-WFR)

Online and in-person 5-day course providing anyone working or playing in wilderness settings with the skills and confidence to administer emergency care when evacuation is hours or days away.

WHEN: Feb 8 - 12, 2021

COST: \$825

INCLUDED: 20-30 hours online and 5 days on-site instruction, lodging and meals.



Hybrid Remote Medicine Upgrade & Recertification (H-RMUR)

Online and in-person 5-day course fulfilling all educational requirements to recertify an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and upgrade to Remote Emergency Medical Technician (REMT).

WHEN: Feb 15 - 19, 2021

COST: \$1,695
INCLUDED: 22 hours
online and 5 days on-site
instruction, lodging and meals.



Remote Medicine for Advanced Providers (RMAP)

Online and in-person 5-day course for Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers such as nurses, paramedics, physicians and physician assistants building skills in life-saving techniques developed for challenging and remote settings. WHEN: Feb 22 - 26, 2021

COST: \$1,895
